### Week Four

#### Monday ~ **READ**

READ Luke 7:12-17... Optional, read other miracles of resurrection in Luke 8:49-56, John 11:1-44, Matthew 28:1-20, Matthew 27:50-54 \*www.Biblegateway.com is a great place to view translations/paraphrases of Scripture.

#### Tuesday ~ **COPY**

COPY Luke 7:12-17 in your preferred translation or paraphrase.

#### Wednesday ~ **PONDER**

\*Take note, the miracles Jesus performs reveal He is Lord over everything, this one... His Lordship over death.

- **IDENTIFY**– What miracle took place in Luke 7:12-17? Can you recall other times Jesus revealed His lordship over death? Journal a list.
- **CONSIDER** the different dynamics of this miracle... what they tell us about Jesus and what they speak to us...
  - **The loss of this mother ?** What kinds of loss had this mother experienced. And who was she surrounded by? Journal your thoughts.
  - **Jesus reaction to her?** When Jesus saw her, how did He feel toward her and what did He speak to her? Also, consider how He knew that this was her son and how old her son was? Journal your thoughts.
  - **The reaction of the coffin bearers?** Why do you think they halted when Jesus touched the coffin? What might have been going through their minds? Do you think something may have happened inside the coffin at His touch before He even spoke? Journal your thoughts.
  - **The moment when the son sat up!** Verses 14-15 reveal that when Jesus spoke, the young man who had been dead sat up, opened his eyes and began to speak! Amazing! Consider this moment and what might have been going through the minds of all who were present... the young man, his mother, the disciples, the people who were mourning, the coffin bearers, and Jesus. Journal your thoughts.
  - **The report that went out about Jesus.** Verses 16-17 give us a general description of the people's response that they reported to all those in the surrounding areas. What was it?
- **PERSONALLY PONDER** – for this mother, her son was already in the coffin and her friends and family were accompanying her to his funeral. But Jesus is Lord over death! His touch and His word brought life! For each of us, there may be people or things in our lives that may already be or may as well be in the "coffin" too... as we, and all those around us are in mourning. Are there people/things in your life that match that description? What life giving change could a touch and word from Jesus could bring? Journal your thoughts.

#### Thursday ~ **PRAY**

PRAY Use the prompts below to pray into the Truths of Luke 7:12-17

- **PRAISE JESUS** as the only One Who is Lord over death!
- **THANK JESUS** for His compassion when He sees us in death and for His power to overcome it in our lives.
- **ASK JESUS** to see you and to speak life to any kind of death that He sees you walking in.
- **DECLARE** that as Jesus is Lord over death in your life and in the lives of those you love!

#### Friday ~ **LISTEN**
