



## What is my PURPOSE in Christ?

### 1. To walk worthy of the calling I have received

As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received.

### 2. For good works

For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

*Ephesians 2:10 (NIV)*



### 3. To be the light of the world

In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.

*Matthew 5:16 (NIV)*



### 4. To be His witness

... But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

*Acts 1:8 (NIV)*



### 5. To be His ambassador

We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God.

*II Corinthians 5:20 (NIV)*



## 6. To be a sweet aroma

But thanks be to God, who always leads us as captives in Christ's triumphal procession and uses us to spread the aroma of the knowledge of him everywhere. <sup>15</sup> For we are to God the pleasing aroma of Christ among those who are being saved and those who are perishing.

## 7. To be an instrument of righteousness

Do not offer any part of yourself to sin as an instrument of wickedness, but rather offer yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life; and offer every part of yourself to him as an instrument of righteousness.

*Romans 6:13 (NIV)*



## 8. To bear the fruit of love

You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last—and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you. <sup>17</sup> This is my command: Love each other.

## 9. To be conformed to His image

For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters.

## 10. To be a priest proclaiming His excellencies

But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

*I Peter 2:9 (NIV)*



## 11. To be His temple

Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; <sup>20</sup> you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies.

## **12. To live for Him**

And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again.
