



## What is my PURPOSE in Christ?

### 1. To walk worthy of the calling I have received

Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called.

### 2. For good works

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.

*Ephesians 2:10 (NASB)*



### 3. To be the light of the world

Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.

*Matthew 5:16 (NASB)*



### 4. To be His witness

... but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth.

*Acts 1:8 (NASB)*



### 5. To be His ambassador

Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were making an appeal through us; we beg you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.

*II Corinthians 5:20 (NASB)*



## 6. To be a sweet aroma

But thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and manifests through us the sweet aroma of the knowledge of Him in every place. <sup>15</sup> For we are a fragrance of Christ to God among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing.

*II Corinthians 2:14-15 (NASB)*



## 7. To be an instrument of righteousness

... and do not go on presenting the members of your body to sin as instruments of unrighteousness; but present yourselves to God as those alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.

*Romans 6:13 (NASB)*



## 8. To bear the fruit of love

You did not choose Me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit, and *that* your fruit would remain, so that whatever you ask of the Father in My name He may give to you.<sup>17</sup> This I command you, that you love one another.

*John 15:16-17 (NASB)*



## 9. To be conformed to His image

For those whom He foreknew, He also predestined *to become* conformed to the image of His Son, so that He would be the firstborn among many brethren.

*Romans 8:29 (NASB)*



## 10. To be a priest proclaiming His excellencies

But you are A CHOSEN RACE, A royal PRIESTHOOD, A HOLY NATION, A PEOPLE FOR *God's* OWN POSSESSION, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light.

*I Peter 2:9 (NASB)*



## 11. To be His temple

Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own? <sup>20</sup> For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body.

*I Corinthians 6:19-20 (NASB)*



## **12. To live for Him**

... and He died for all, so that they who live might no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died and rose again on their behalf.

*II Corinthians 5:15 (NASB)*



## **13. To be revealed with Him in glory**

When Christ, who is our life, is revealed, then you also will be revealed with Him in glory.

*Colossians 3:4 (NASB)*
