

Communion is...

Communion is a Divine meal, and I have been given a Divine seat at the table.

Read Matthew 26:26-28

The Communion meal is not a potluck where everyone brings something. **No, the Communion meal is a Divine Meal** where only One, Jesus, provides the rich food that we partake.

Jesus is the One Who invites us to the table, provides the food, prepares the food, offers the food and blesses the food before we partake. **We bring nothing but a desire to be at His Divine table.** What a privilege to have a seat there. And when we come, we receive.

So... we need to make sure that we come to the Communion table with that mindset, instead of a mindset of, "What do you want me to bring?" You know that mindset, right? Someone invites you to dinner and you ask what you can bring and they say, "Nothing" but you still make effort to bring something anyway, even if it is just flowers for the table, because you feel badly if you don't contribute.

I think we can easily take on that mindset about the Communion table. But the reality is we have nothing to bring. **This meal is Divine and it can only be prepared and served by Jesus.** He took the bread, He blessed it, He broke it and He said, **"Take and eat."** Then He took the cup and He gave thanks and He invited them to drink. And He said, **"This is My blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many..."** You and I are ones of the many seated at this Divine table, receiving of what He provides.

Today as we partake, may we remember that we bring nothing, and that we are highly privileged to have a seat at His Divine table.

Jesus what a privilege to be seated at Your table, at Your Divine meal. I wish that I had something to bring, yet I know that I don't. But I am so thankful to be at Your table, and I willingly receive of the nourishment and LIFE You have prepared for me.
