Week Three

Monday ~ **READ**

READ Romans 8:35-39 and Jeremiah 31:3 in your preferred translation. Then read Romans 8:35-39 out loud exchanging the word "us" for the word "me".

Tuesday ~ **COPY**

COPY Romans 8:35-39 and Jeremiah 31:3 from your preferred translation.

- After copying, pick out one phrase from the Romans passage that is the most meaningful to you, and then copy that phrase from three or more additional translations.
- Also, copy Jeremiah 31:3 from the Message Translation.

Wednesday ~ **PONDER**

PONDER Romans 8:35-39 and Jeremiah 31:3 by using the following prompts:

- Romans 8:35-39 is really a more detailed way of God saying what He said in Jeremiah 31:3. In the Romans passage, we find many things listed that could cause us to think that God no longer loves us. Pick 7 of these many things and write them out as statements like this example: "***The distress of _____ will not separate me from God's love.***" Doing this will reinforce the Truth of His unfailing constant love.
- Reverse the thought process. Romans 8:35-39 is about God's love for us... it won't ever stop. But what about our love for God. Ask yourself, "***What are the things that I allow to separate God from my love?***" Make a list. Then using your list, write out a statement likened to Romans 8:38 that would be worded something like this, "***For I am committed that neither _____, _____, _____, _____, _____ will separate God from my love for Him.***" Doing this will reinforce your commitment to loving God.
- Romans 8:36 makes it clear that the "***death***" of this world is trying to destroy us. But verse 37 gives us Truth to know that God's love provides an "***overwhelming victory***" for us in any challenge. Ask the Holy Spirit to minister the meaning of this Truth to you from verse 37... and as He does, journal your thoughts.

Thursday ~ **PRAY**

PRAY these passages. As it says in Jeremiah 31:3, "***God has always loved us and He always will...***" We need to pray from that standpoint. Pray through Romans 8:35-39 three times... first for yourself, secondly for a loved one, thirdly for an enemy.

Friday ~ **LISTEN**
