### Week Two

#### Monday ~ **READ**

READ John 6:1-14. And then, read this same miracle found in Matthew 14:13-21, Mark 6:33-43 & Luke 9:12-17.

#### Tuesday ~ **COPY**

COPY Matthew John 6:1-14 in your preferred translation or paraphrase.

#### Wednesday ~ **PONDER**

\*Take note, the miracles Jesus performs reveal He is Lord over everything, this one... His Lordship over our needs.

- **IDENTIFY**– What is the miracle in Matthew 8:23-27? How does it reveal Jesus Lordship over our needs? Can you also think of other miracles Jesus performed that reveal this as well? Journal your thoughts.
- **CONSIDER** – This miracle reveals many things about Jesus... consider:
  - **Why people followed Him?** Verse 1-2 tell us why some were following Jesus, what does it say? What are other reasons why people follow Him. Why do you follow Him? Journal your thoughts.
  - **Why He fed the 5000?** As you read through the passage and also the accounts of this miracle in the other Gospels, consider Jesus' motives in feeding the people in this way. Ask the Holy Spirit to give you revelation to see His heart and the fullness of what He was doing. Journal what you find.
  - **How He provides?** Jesus clearly wanted His disciples to experience His power to provide. When He asked the disciples about feeding the people, what was their response in verses 7-9? But what was His response in verses 10-11? And how much did He provide (see verses 11-13)? Journal what you find.
  - **His Lordship over our needs.** When Jesus *"lifts His eyes"* and looks at you, what needs does He see? When you look at those same need in your life, what reasons do you give that your needs can't be provided for? Considering what we see in this miracle, are your reasons a challenge for Jesus? Journal your thoughts.
  - **What He needs to perform a miracle.** – Consider what Jesus needs to perform any miracle of provision. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide your thinking and then journal your thoughts.

#### Thursday ~ **PRAY**

PRAY Use the prompts below to pray into the Truths of John 6:1-14.

- **PRAISE JESUS** as the One Who is Lord over every need!
- **THANK JESUS** for His compassion and care for our needs and thank Him ahead of time for providing.
- **ASK JESUS** to renew your thoughts about the needs in your life, and to see Him as your provision.
- **TALK TO JESUS** about trusting Him to provide more than enough.
- **DECLARE** that Jesus is Lord over every need you have!

#### Friday ~ **LISTEN**
