



Years ago I became familiar with the Old Testament Biblical word "*lovingkindness*" and discovered a powerful description of God's love for us. And as I explored it in the Bible, I found phrase after phrase of so many different ways God expresses His love to us!

**"Lovingkindness" is translated from the Hebrew word "*chesed*" meaning the loyal goodness, kindness and faithfulness of God!**



God's tender hearted, full on, loyal affection for us is expressed in these ways and best described as His "*lovingkindness*" in the NASB and KJV versions of the Old Testament. It is one thing to generally say, "God loves me," but how much more impacting to ponder and meditate upon all the ways He expresses His love. I am convinced every child of God needs a deep revelation of God's love poured out upon our lives. I know I do! As you copy these many expressions of God's lovingkindness, it is my prayer that you will deeply ponder each one, and your heart will come alive to His love like never before!
