EF QUESTIONS

Day 8

In Peter's testimony we see him experience many spiritual highs and lows. In your journal make two columns labeling them, Spiritual Highs/Spiritual Lows. Then list things from Peter's testimony that belong in each one. After completing your lists, journal any observations or thoughts that come to mind about Jesus, Peter, or yourself.

Day 9

There is a distinctive difference between pre-Pentecost Peter and post-Pentecost Peter. Observe this by comparing Luke 22:54-62 and Acts 4:1-31, and also by comparing other things you may recall from your reading. Journal your thoughts about how and why this difference in Peter came about and also consider moment(s) in your life that left a marked difference in your own discipleship transformation.

Day 10

Considering what you read of Peter as a disciple and apostle of Jesus, and also the content of what he wrote in I and II Peter, can you identify specific things that he wrote in those two letters that could be connected to his experiences as a disciple and apostle? Journal your thoughts.

Day 11

If you could step into Peter's life as a disciple of Jesus and experience one of his moments, which one would it be and why? How do you think you would have responded? And how might this experience influence your relationship with Jesus? Journal your thoughts.

What part of Peter's testimony will you focus on in creating your own questions? Why?
