### Week Two

#### Monday ~ **READ**

**READ** Hebrews 1 in several translations. This chapter about Jesus includes many Old Testament prophecies about Him. Make sure to read a translation of this chapter that makes sense to you. If your usual translation does not, I recommend The New Living Translation for this chapter.

#### Tuesday ~ **COPY**

**COPY** Hebrews 1 from the translation that you settled on yesterday.

#### Wednesday ~ **PONDER**

**PONDER** Hebrews 1 using the following:

\*Make sure to ask the Holy Spirit to reveal what He wants you to see as you consider these things...

- **Throughout Hebrews 1**, there are many significant Truths revealed about Jesus. Go through the entire chapter word by word, and make note of each Truth you can find, leaving space after each one. \*I made a list of 22 Truths I found in Hebrews 1 and on page 2, I've included my list for your reference. I recommend viewing my list AFTER you have made your own list.
- **In the space you left beside each Truth about Jesus on your list**, go back and write out an accompanying personal question \*I also included my questions on my list to give you an example of what I mean by this.
- **Pick at least 5 of the Truths about Jesus from your list.** Ponder what each one reveals about Him and journal your thoughts. After that, answer the accompanying question you created about yourself.

#### Thursday ~ **PRAY**

**PRAY** - Using the list of Truths about Jesus that you gleaned from Hebrews 1, pray with these four thoughts in mind for each one:

- Is there something in this Truth for which you should express praise or thankfulness to God?... then do so.
- Is there something in this Truth for which you should express humility to God? ... then do so.
- Is there something in this Truth you should aspire to emulate about Jesus? ...then ask God for help.
- Is there something in this Truth that brings about conviction in your heart?... then confess and ask God for His forgiveness.

#### Friday ~ **LISTEN**

## Hebrews 1... list by Sharon Thomas

- Verse 1... Jesus is the voice God used to speak to world in these last days  
Do I listen to Jesus?
- Verse 2... Jesus was appointed by God to be heir of all things  
Has Jesus inherited me and my life yet?
- Verse 2... Jesus created the world  
Do I live as if Jesus is my Creator and owns my life?
- Verse 3... Jesus is the radiance of God's glory  
Have I stopped lately to look at the radiance of Jesus? If so, what have I seen?
- Verse 3... Jesus is the exact representation of God's nature  
Do I believe this Truth about Jesus?
- Verse 3... Jesus upholds all things by the Word of His power  
What is Jesus upholding right now in my life by the Word of His power?
- Verse 3... Jesus made purification for sins  
Am I resistant or yielding to Jesus purifying sin in me?
- Verse 3... Jesus is seated at the right hand of God  
Do I realize that Jesus has given me a seat beside Him there?
- Verse 4... Jesus has a greater, more excellent name than angels (His messengers)  
How am I upholding Jesus' name above all others?
- Verse 5... Jesus is God's Son, God begot Him  
How does this make Jesus different from me?
- Verse 6... Jesus is to be worshipped by the angels of God (His messengers)  
I am also called to worship Him; how am I doing so?
- Verse 8... Jesus' throne will endure forever  
Where is my focus, on His throne, or on this world that will get rolled up like an old garment?
- Verse 8... Jesus' righteous scepter is the scepter of the kingdom  
What does this mean? And what difference should it make in my life?
- Verse 9... Jesus loved righteousness  
Do I love righteousness? How do I express my love for righteousness?
- Verse 9... Jesus hated sin  
Do I hate sin? How do I express my hatred for sin?
- Verse 9... Jesus was anointed by God with the oil of gladness above all others  
God blessed Jesus with this anointing because He loved righteousness and hated sin. Have I also received this blessing?
- Verse 10... Jesus laid the foundations of the earth  
Do I live and think and express my will in this earth with this knowing at my core?
- Verse 10... Jesus hands created the heavens  
Can I even imagine what heaven looks like? What would be my greatest dream about heaven?
- V.11-12... Jesus will never change, but the world will  
How does this Truth about Jesus stabilize my life?
- Verse 12... Jesus' years will never come to an end  
How is this same blessing also transferred to me as I am in Christ?
- Verse 13... Jesus enemies will become a footstool for His feet  
What enemies is Jesus already resting His feet upon? What enemies can I trust that He will rest His feet on in the future?  
How should this encourage me and bring me peace?
- Verse 14... Jesus sends out angels to minister to those who will inherit salvation  
Have I ever encountered an angel? How do I know?
